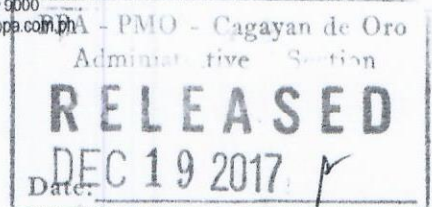

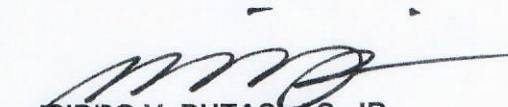
SUBJECT : Full Implementation of the Online System for Notice of Arrival and Application for Berth/Anchorage (Online NOA/ABA System)

In the interest of public service and in support of the government's commitment to enhance Philippine competitiveness through e-Governance as laid out in the Philippine E-Commerce Roadmap 2016-2020, the Philippine Ports Authority has rolled-out the Online System for Notice of Arrival and Application for Berth/Anchorage (Online NOA/ABA System) which aims to facilitate ease of doing business at the ports particularly in the processing of berth allocation at PPA-managed and controlled ports.

In this regard, this PMO enjoins all concerned port stakeholders to utilize the Online NOA/ABA System and to take advantage of its benefits. An Online NOA/ABA Users' Manual is now available at the PPA website (<http://www.ppa.com.ph>) to serve as reference guide. To access the Manual, Users may simply do the following:
