SUBJECT : ENSURING BREAKBULK CARGOES ARE **APPROPRIATELY** PACKED, PACKAGED AND/OR SECURED ON BOARD THE

VESSELS

In line with the provisions of the PPA Orange Book on Safety Health and Environment Management in Ports and with the implementation of the Integrated Management System at the Port of Cagayan de Oro, Shipping Line Companies are hereby required to make certain that breakbulk cargoes laden for the Port of Cagayan de Oro are properly/appropriately packed, packaged and secured ensuring that the same are safe to be handled on board vessel and stored in the port.

Breakbulk cargoes found to be unsafe for loading/unloading from/to vessel due to improper packing, packaging, and securing, the CHO shall coordinate with PPA PMO MOC and the Shipping Line Representative. The shipping line representatives shall undertake safety measures to rectify the condition of the breakbulk cargo to ensure the safe handling thereof. Otherwise, incoming/outgoing breakbulk cargoes of unsafe condition/ unsafely packed/secured shall not be handled unless rectification of safety measures shall have been done.

The said PPA Memo Order shall be effective immediately.
