CALENDAR OF ACTIVITIES AND PERIODS OF CERTAIN PROHIBITED ACTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE UPCOMING

NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS ON 13 MAY 2019

In view of the national and local elections on 13 May 2019, government officials and employees are hereby reminded to observe the calendar of activities for the said elections and adhere to the pertinent laws, issuances, and policies relative to prohibited acts for specified periods relative thereto (See attached COMELEC Resolution No. 10429).

This Memorandum Circular highlights, among others, the following prohibited acts to be observed by this PMO and its personnel as civil servants throughout the period covered:

Date/Period	Prohibited Acts
January 13, 2019 (Sunday) to June 12, 2019 (Wednesday)	Bearing, carrying or transporting firearms or other deadly weapons, unless authorized in writing by the Commission. (Sec.32, RA 7166)
March 29, 2019 (Friday) to May 12, 2019 (Sunday)	Appointment or hiring of new employees, creation or filing up of new positions; promotion or giving or salary increases, remuneration or privilege. (Sec. 261 (g), OEC)
	Construction of public works, delivery of materials for public works and issuance of treasury warrant or similar devises for a future undertaking chargeable against public fund. (Sec. 261 (w), OEC)
	Release, disbursement or expenditures of public funds. (Section 261 (v), OEC)
May 12-13, 2019	Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving, or taking intoxicating liquor. (Section 261 (dd), OEC)
