SUBJECT: BANNED ENTRY OF MR. JAYVEE CAPURAS AND ROBERTO SARNO AT THE PORT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO

MESSAGE: It has come to the attention of this Office that an uploaded video material showing several port workers in the act of pulling out items from the apprehended bundles of used clothing was posted on social media (Facebook) sometime on May 23 or 24, 2019 and allegedly, the video was taken at the Port of Cagayan de Oro. This Office immediately conducted investigation to verify the veracity of the uploaded video thru the Port Police Division. Results of Investigation Report reveals that indeed, such incident had transpired in the Port of Cagayan de Oro. Accordingly, the operatives of PCG and BOC had apprehended sixty (60) bundles of used clothing (Ukay-ukay) last 21 March 2019 and the group ordered the unloading of said cargoes from M/V Trans Asia 19. And while the subject cargoes were stockpiled on the dockside of the port, several port workers/laborers have deliberately been pulling out items from the bundled cargoes which the uploader has able to capture this undesirable occurrence and posted same on the social media. Based on the statements of the witnesses and pieces of evidence gathered by PPD, investigation discloses that two (2) individuals identified as Jayvee A. Capuras and Roberto C. Sarno , both laborers of perishable goods and employed under the shipper Randy Castillo and Robert Limuel Flores, respectively, have been proven to be responsible of such unlawful acts in which, as per port policy, are subject to sanction/s as recommended by the Authority. Moreover, both respondents had openly admitted the allegations charged against them during investigation.	

In view of the foregoing and in continuing implementation of International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code and in accordance to pertinent PPA regulations and Port Security Advisories issued by this PMO specifically on Items 5 and 7 of PSA No. 02-2018 dated 7 March 2018, this Office hereby issues this Advisory to notify the port's security personnel, shippers and other port stakeholders that the following individuals whose names were highlighted/captioned above has been **BANNED FOR ENTRY** hereafter. As such, the privilege of Mr. Capuras and Mr. Sarno to enter the port has been cancelled and both shall be immediately removed from the master lists of their respective shippers and shall not be allowed to render any kind of labor/services within the port premises.

Port Police Officers on duty and Shift-in-Charge guards shall ensure strict implementation of this order.

This Advisory takes effect immediately and shall remain in force, unless subject individuals have been reinstated by this Office.
