
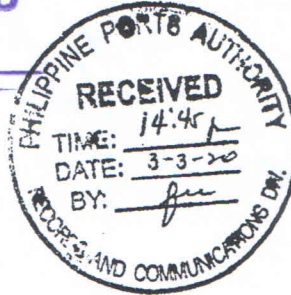
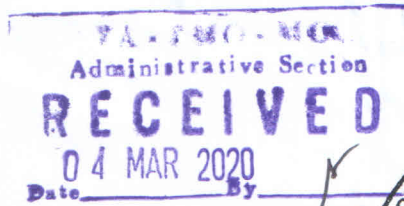

<p>Respectfully disseminating herewith is PPA Memorandum Circular No. 06-2020 with the above captioned subject (hereto attached). Consequently, PPA MC No. 02-2020 which was previously disseminated by this Office thru PMO-MOC PABA No. PPD 010-2020 dated 2 March 2020 is hereby amended to include <b>South Korea</b> in the coverage of its guidelines.</p> <p>In view hereof and in line with recent case of local transmission of COVID-19 in the Philippines as reported by the Department of Health, everyone is encouraged to practice proper handwashing procedures, observe social distancing and exercise cough etiquette. Further, all are directed to sustain and/or enhance institution of measures and other related preventive and monitoring activities within your respective AOR to contain the virus in close coordination with DOH-BOQ, LGUs and other concerned units.</p> <p>Hence, everyone is advised to be vigilant and to continue doing your roles within your respective AOR to prevent the spread of the disease.</p> <p>For guidance, ready reference and appropriate action.</p>

SUBJECT : **AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 02-2020  
TO INCLUDE SOUTH KOREA IN THE COVERAGE  
THEREOF**

On February 26, 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for Emerging Infectious Diseases (EID) approved the temporary ban from entering in the Philippines of any person, except Filipino citizens, including their foreign spouse and children, if any, holders of permanent Resident Visa, and holders of 9(e) Diplomat Visas, who has been to the North Gyeongsang Province of the Republic of Korea, including Daegu and Cheongdo, within the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding in the Philippines.

Accordingly, Section II (Coverage) of Memorandum Circular No. 02-2020 is further amended to read, as follows:

**“ II. Coverage**

These guidelines shall apply to:

1. All arriving vessels that have called at ports in China and its Special Administrative Regions (SARs), and South Korea in the past fourteen (14) days.
2. All arriving vessels with crew and/or passengers who have travelled to China and its SARs, and South Korea in the past fourteen (14) days.”

All other provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 02-2020 not otherwise inconsistent herewith shall remain valid.

This Memorandum Circular takes effect immediately.
