Disseminated herewith for information is the letter from Atty. Jay Daniel R. Santiago, General Manager, Philippine Ports Authority, in reference to his memorandum dated 01 October 2018 directing all Port Managers to ensure that by the end of 2018, all port service providers under their areas of jurisdiction are accredited by the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA).

In view of the appeal of stakeholders and PMOs, the deadline for filing of application for PPA Accreditation of port service providers is hereby extended up to 30 June 2019. However, all entities who will participate in the bidding under PPA Administrative Order No. 12-2018, entitled "Guidelines on the Selection and Award of Contract Under the Port Terminal Management Regulatory Framework (PTMRF)" shall be required first to secure PPA Accreditation.

In line hereof, during the extended period, expiring/expired Permit to Operate (PTO) or Hold Order Authority (HOA) may be renewed sans PPA accreditation, subject to the usual procedures of PTO or HOA renewal, succeeding renewal applications shall not be allowed without PPA Accreditation.

Please be guided accordingly.



COMPLY EXTENSION OF TIME TO

ACCREDITATION OF PORT SERVICE PROVIDERS

This is with reference to the Memorandum dated October 1, 2018 of the undersigned directing all Port Managers to ensure that by end of 2018, all port service providers under their areas of jurisdiction are accredited by the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA).

In view of the appeal of stakeholders and PMOs, the deadline for filing of application for PPA Accreditation of port service providers is hereby extended up to June 30, 2019. The extended deadline is set to prevent disruption of the provision of port services for 2019 and afford the PMOs and Head Office reasonable time to process all applications for PPA Accreditation.

However, all entities who will participate in the bidding under PPA Administrative Order No.12-2018, entitled "Guidelines on the Selection and Award of Contract Under the Port Terminal Management Regulatory Framework (PTMRF)" shall be required first to secure PPA Accreditation. Proponents of unsolicited proposals shall also be required first to apply for PPA accreditation.

During the extended period, an expiring or expired Permit to Operate (PTO) or Hold Over Authority (HOA) may be renewed sans PPA accreditation, subject to the usual procedures for PTO or IIOA renewal. Succeeding PTO or HOA renewal applications shall not be allowed without PPA Accreditation.

All Port Managers are hereby directed to institute procedures within the PMOs for the successful implementation of the new PPA Accreditation Policy by June 30, 2019.
