MANDATORY CHECKING OF VEHICLES' ENGINE

COMPARTMENT DURING SECURITY INSPECTION AT

THE PORT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO

Please be informed that the Port Facility have been continuously receiving intelligence reports from reliable sources regarding the alleged plan of suspected terrorists to carry out atrocities in the region utilizing anonymous vehicles prompting the facility to implement target hardening measures to ensure safety of all port users and stakeholders. And as such, this Office has to ensure that all vehicles entering the port facility has legitimate purpose and free from any incendiary and/or explosive devices.

In view of the foregoing and pursuant to our continuing implementation of the International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code, this Office hereby requires all vehicles including bank armored cars entering the ports' access gates to open its car engine hood during security inspection aside from the routine security inspection which includes under-chassis inspection using the goose-neck mirror, opening of the baggage compartment, rolling down of the vehicle's window and turning "ON" the vehicle's interior light during nighttime.

As a matter of policy, the ports' security personnel reserves that right to disallow entry of any vehicle or person who refuses to undergo above-cited security procedures and shall be subjected to further verification and investigation by the Authority.
