**SUBJECT :** **UTILIZATION OF AREA "N" AS TEMPORARY  
PARKING AREA TO ALL PPA-OWNED VEHICLES AND  
PERSONAL VEHICLES OF PPA EMPLOYEES**

In view of the continuing implementation of International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code and pertinent PPA regulations, and in order to provide sufficient parking space to port users transacting business at Assessment, Billing and Collection Unit (ABCU) Building and to avert possible traffic congestion at the PMO's designated parking area (Area "M"), which is presently undergoing major rehabilitation, please be respectfully informed that the parking area for all PPA-owned vehicles as well as personal vehicles of both regular and outsourced personnel of this Office shall be temporarily transferred to Area "N". The old passenger gate located beside the ABCU Building shall be utilized as temporary ingress/egress point to those authorized vehicles only *en route* to Area "N" which will be made available from 0600H to 1800H.

In this regard, the following guidelines shall be implemented:

1. JMT Construction, contractor of the said construction project, will provide one (1) security personnel who will be posted on the said gate to ensure that only authorized vehicles and pedestrians can gain access thereat.
2. A master list of vehicles, indicating therein the Plate Numbers and the owner of the vehicle, shall be provided to the guard assigned thereat for easy identification.
3. Only those included on the list provided shall be allowed to gain access thereat.
4. At exactly 1800H, said gate will be closed and padlocked. Hence, all authorized vehicles who intends to gain access *en route* to Area "N" and vice versa beyond the aforementioned time shall utilized Gate 4 as entry and exit point.

5. Authorized personnel shall utilized Gate 3A as entry/exit point to/from the PMO-Administration Building 1. Subsequently, one (1) PPA-hired security personnel will be deployed at Gate 3A to ensure that only organic and outsourced personnel of this Office shall gain access thereat.

This advisory is only temporary and shall cease upon the completion of the construction project at Area "M" unless sooner revoked by this Office.
