MESSAGE:

In compliance with PPA MC 18-2020 re Guidelines for the Prevention, Control and Mitigation of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) in the Offices and Facilities of the Philippine Ports Authority and PPA MC 36-2020 re Guidelines on the Use of TRAZE Contact Tracing Application, entry to the port by all persons shall be through the use of TRAZE Contact Tracing application designed jointly by PPA in-house IT experts and third party developer Cosmotech Philippines, Inc. It is aimed at readily detecting contact/s of an identified COVID-19 positive person who have entered the port premises and undertake preventive measures to contain the possible spread of the infection.

Minimum requirements to download the TRAZE application are the following:

- A network-ready mobile phone capable of installing the TRAZE application downloadable from Google Play, Samsung Galaxy Store and Appgallery for android phone users, and Appstore for iPhone/iOS smartphone users;
- At least 5.7 mb internal space to install the application;
- Sufficient space to use the application.

Once installed in the device, user may register in the application as an individual and scan the QR code posted at designated entry points of the port. Download and installation guides/instructions are posted at Gate 4, Gate 3, Building 1 Entrance, and Passenger Terminal Complex. Port Police personnel shall provide assistance in downloading, installation and registration in the application.

Those who have no internet-capable devices may go to the Malasakit Helpdesks located in the following sites to register and get his/her QR code for scanning upon entry:

- a. Gate 4
- b. Building 1 Entrance
- c. Passenger Terminal Complex
- d. Building 2

Offices, ticketing outlets and stores inside the port shall also register as Establishment and make the following available at their windows/entrances:

- 1. QR code of establishment for scanning by co-employees/passengers/clients;
- Smartphone with installed TRAZE application for scanning of QR code of coemployees/passengers/clients who have no smartphone.

Entry to the port through TRAZE shall be mandatory effective 28 November 2020.
