<p>In view of the recent weather bulletin issued by Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAG-ASA) for Tropical Depression "Vicky" at 1400H 18 December 2020 of which ports under this PMO's Areas of Responsibility were placed under Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal #1 and in compliance to Sea Travel Advisory No. 1220-001 issued by the HQ of Philippine Coast Guard District – NoMin and Sea Travel Advisory No. 1 issued by Philippine Coast Guard Station – Camiguin, vessel trips at the Baseport and at the Terminal Ports of Camiguin and Balingoan are hereby suspended temporarily effective 0800H 18 December 2020.</p> <p>Lifting of vessel trip suspension shall be announced as soon as weather condition on areas under this PMO's AOR improves and upon advised by the Philippine Coast Guard.</p> <p>In view hereof, concerned ship owners/ship operators, shippers, consignees and other port stakeholders are advised to observe the aforesaid sea travel advisories (<i>herein attached</i>) until further notice.</p> <p>For guidance and ready reference.</p>

In view of the hoisting of tropical cyclone warning signal No.1 in Northern Mindanao, and among other areas in the country brought by the TD "VICKY", temporary suspension of voyages for all types of vessels/watercrafts is hereby announced effective 180800H December 2020 plying within the area of responsibility of CGDNM, to wit:



Subject announcement is in conformance to the existing HPCG/CG-8 MC Nr 02-2013 dated 05 June 2013 (Guidelines on Movement of Vessels during Heavy Weather).

Exemption from the suspension applies to Special Areas as prescribed in the aforementioned MC. Further, vessels who intend to take shelter shall be permitted as long as it is manifested through written request and no passenger shall be allowed onboard.

Lifting of suspension shall be announced as soon as weather condition improves.

## SEA TRAVEL ADVISORY NO.1

In reference to PAGASA Severe Weather Bulletin number 02 as of 8:00 AM today, December 18, 2020 Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) Number 1 was hoisted in Camiguin, Province and Balingoan, Misamis Oriental brought by Tropical Depression "VICKY".

In this regard, trips of vessels from Port of Benoni, Camiguin, Province to Port of Balingoan, Misamis Oriental and vice versa are all CANCELLED. Be guided on the HPCG Memorandum Circular No. 02-13 (Guidelines on Movement of Vessel during Heavy Weather). "No vessel on any type of tonnage shall be allowed to sail except to take shelter, as the situation may warrant, when Public Storm Warning Signal (PSWS) Number 1 or Higher is hoisted within its point of origin, the intended route, and point of destination."
