SUBJECT: REITERATION ON THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS IN PORTS UNDER PMO-MOC

MESSAGE: This has reference to the Advisory issued by Region 10 Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (R10 IATF-MEID) dated 12 May 2021 requesting intensification on the enforcement of minimum public health standards in ports under PMO Misamis Oriental/Cagayan de Oro to further prevent and mitigate the spread of COVID-19 virus due to recent reported upsurge of COVID cases in the region as recorded by the Department of Health. This PMO hereby reiterates its previous advisories/issuances on the adherence of minimum public health protocols upon entry and while inside the ports under this PMO, to wit: PABA No. PPD 002-2020 dated 23 January 2020 – “...all frontline personnel of this PMO are directed to wear the appropriate face mask during duty...” <i>(Please refer to Annex A)</i> PABA No. PPD 012-2020 dated 6 March 2020 – “...everyone is encouraged to practice proper handwashing procedures, observe social distancing and exercise cough etiquette...” <i>(Please refer to Annex B)</i> PABA No. PPD 027-2020 dated 5 May 2020 – (As cited on attached file [Annex C] specifically on Section II, Item Nos: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. All personnel must wear face masks and other appropriate PPEs in the workplace. Frontliners are encouraged to wear face shields with medical masks.2. Sanitation protocols must be observed by personnel, clients and visitors prior to entry into the building/facility including thermal scanning, footbaths, hand washing and sanitation tents. PABA No. PPD 017-2021 dated 24 April 2021 – “...Minimum public health standards, which include physical distancing, hand hygiene, cough etiquette,	

and wearing of face masks and face shields, among others, shall continue to be strictly implemented and enforced...”(Please refer to Annex D)

PABA No. PPD 020-2021 dated 4 May 2021 – “...eating together is strongly discouraged among employees during meal time. Chatting together physically in group is also discouraged, even among fellow Division employees...Visitors shall be allowed only at the designated receiving areas of each responsibility center and shall be limited to two visitors only at a time. Food delivery crew are strictly not allowed inside offices....” (Please refer to Annex E)

In view thereof, PPA personnel, Cargo Handling Operators, ship owners/ship operators, shippers, consignees, port workers and other port stakeholders are advised to observe the aforesaid health protocols at all times while inside the port premises.
