Dear Colleagues,

In compliance with Proclamation No. 282 declaring August as ASEAN Month (copy attached), the Department once again requests the vital support and participation of all agencies in implementing programs/campaigns in commemoration of the 55th ASEAN Anniversary in August 2022 and raising ASEAN awareness among the public.

The Department is organizing virtual activities this year with the theme "ASEAN Youth: Embracing Identity Towards an Empowered Future", which will focus on ASEAN youth as well as ASEAN Identity and Community, in line with Cambodia's 2022 chairmanship theme, "ASEAN A.C.T.: Addressing Challenges Together," as well as ASEAN's declaration of 2022 as the "Year of ASEAN Youth."

Planned activities include a Special Flag-Raising Ceremony with ASEAN Day Reception which will be held in conjunction with the ASEAN Coffee and Breakfast Festival on 10 August 2022 at the Department of Foreign Affairs; a Tree-Planting Activity for the ASEAN Ambassadors at the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity; a social media campaign in TikTok showcasing Traditional Southeast Asian Games; an ASEAN anniversary Facebook frame and ASEAN Day Card; placement of ASEAN flags along Roxas Boulevard; a display of the ASEAN Emblem on the Mall of Asia LED Globe; a new series of ASEAN 101 infographics; and a possible webinar about the aforementioned theme, among others.

The Department requests assistance in promoting the 55th ASEAN anniversary and its related activities within government agencies, schools, universities, and the private sector, and encourages agencies to consider organizing their own ASEAN awareness activities. Due to limitations still caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, agencies may also consider conducting various online activities, such as webinars, messages/greetings from heads of agencies, infographic campaigns, and virtual flag-raising ceremonies and exhibits.

### PROCLAMATION NO. 282

# AMENDING PROCLAMATION NO. 1008 (S. 1997) TO DECLARE THE MONTH OF AUGUST OF EVERY YEAR AS "ASEAN MONTH"

WHEREAS, the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) was founded on 08 August 1967 in Bangkok, Thailand to promote economic, social and cultural development of the region through cooperative programs, to safeguard the political and economic stability of the region, and to serve as a forum for the resolution of intra-regional differences;

WHEREAS, the Philippines is a founding member and has been one of the active members of the ASEAN;

**WHEREAS**, the ASEAN's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary coincides with the country's Chairmanship of the Association in 2017;

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 1008 (s. 1997) declared 07 August to 13 August of every year as "ASEAN Week";

WHEREAS, Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 07 (s. 2017) reiterates the call to all public officials and employees to actively take part in raising the public's awareness of the ASEAN; and

WHEREAS, the Philippines recognizes the need to further promote and heighten awareness of the ASEAN, and instill in the minds of the Filipino people the importance, value and meaning of the ASEAN in achieving and maintaining regional peace and sustainable development.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby amend Proclamation No. 1008 (s. 1997) to declare the month of August of every year as "ASEAN Month."

All government agencies, especially the Department of Foreign Affairs, Department of Education, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Department of Tourism, Department of Trade and Industry, and Commission on Higher Education are enjoined to initiate and implement programs and activities to help generate awareness and public support in promoting the observance of ASEAN Month in the various offices, schools, universities, local government units and business establishments.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


