<p>Respectfully disseminating herewith the Advisory issued by the Bureau of Immigration relative to the full-scale implementation of the e-Travel System on 15 April 2023 wherein crewmembers and passengers of vessels plying international voyages shall be required to register at etravel.gov.ph or scan the QR code which can be found in the attached Advisory.</p> <p>As cited therein, please be further informed that the Bureau of Immigration shall discontinue requiring paper-based arrival/departure cards starting 01 May 2023.</p> <p>In view thereof, concerned shipping lines/shipping agents and other port stakeholders are advised to observe the guidelines provided in the aforesaid Advisory (<i>herein attached</i>), as appropriate.</p> <p>For guidance and ready reference.</p>

ADVISORY

Relative to the full-scale implementation of the e-Travel System, **CREWMEMBERS** and **PASSENGERS OF ALL AIRCRAFTS AND SEACRAFTS** shall be required, commencing on **15 April 2023**, to register at **etravel.gov.ph** or scan the QR code below:

- Arriving passengers: Not earlier than seventy-two (72) hours from the scheduled time of arrival up to actual arrival into the country; and
- Departing passengers: Not earlier than seventy-two (72) hours up to not later than three (3) hours from the scheduled time of departure from the country.

BI shall discontinue requiring paper-based arrival/departure cards starting 01 May 2023.
