<p>In view of the continuing implementation of International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code and the National Security Programme for Sea Transport and Maritime Infrastructure (NSPSTMI) and in compliance with the Transportation Security Alert Advisory (TSAA) 2022-11 issued by Office for Transportation Security (OTS) dated 30 June 2022, security level of ports under the jurisdiction of this PMO is hereby placed under Security Level 1 with Enhanced Security Measures to ensure safety and security of port facilities and the riding public, in general.</p> <p>Anent thereto, all are enjoined to adopt target-hardening measures and implement enhanced security procedures at their respective ports such as but not limited to, stringent screening of passengers and their baggage/luggage, stringent checking of incoming and outgoing cargoes, tighter access control, maximum utilization of Baggage and Body Scanning Machines and Walk-Through Metal Detectors and other target hardening security measures.</p> <p>Moreover, concerned personnel are enjoined to be extra vigilant in monitoring the security situation within your AOR and nearby areas. You are likewise advised to sustain intelligence build-up and closely coordinate with the friendly forces and</p>	

intelligence community operating within your AOR and report immediately thru the PMO's Command Center any received information that may affect the port security for further assessment and validation.

This Advisory takes effect for the month of July 2022, unless sooner revoked or otherwise amended by OTS.

2. Security Threat Situation

The Communist Terrorist Group (CTG) will remain steadfast in its objective to challenge the legitimacy of the Marcos administration. The Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) has issued statements/press releases to condition the minds of the public that the May polls proceedings was rigged and seek sympathy/support from local and foreign benefactors. To note, CTG has failed again to reach its objective for the 2022 elections such as increasing its number of seats in the Congress from five to seven.

During the election period, CPP had issued post-election directives to include among others their call for the resumption of peace talks, alliance building with the opposition, arouse-organize-mobilize people during mass actions, sustained protests against the legitimacy of Marcos administration and regular assessment of its actions to destroy PBBM's popularity. On 30 June, CTG front organizations (CFOs) including transport groups staged protests in Manila, Cebu City, Baguio City, and at Times Square, New York City, USA to reject the Marcos-Duterte administration and to fight for a genuine democracy. The protesters demanded respect for human rights and no to return to martial law. Former Bayan Muna Representative Satur Ocampo said they are ready to hold protest actions if policies of the Marcos administration "are not acceptable." Bayan secretary general Renato Reyes claimed the inauguration ceremony was the culmination of nearly three decades of systematic efforts "to bring about a Marcos restoration." Akbayan party-list said it expects Marcos "to adhere to a low-intensity form of democracy," and vowed to hold the Marcos administration accountable if it broke its campaign promises. Young Global Filipinos for Democracy said that they will "not relent in the fight" for the Marcos and Duterte families "to answer for their crimes" while Anakbayan-USA said the Marcos administration represents "the worst of Philippine patronage politics" and "they will stop at nothing to maintain their power and access to public coffers." International League of People's Struggle said it rejects U.S. President Joe Biden's show of support to the new administration.

CTG will sustain mobilization of forces and supporters, here and abroad, to project disorder and discontent under the Marcos administration. It will maximize the use of social media platforms to conduct propaganda and disinformation campaigns such as electoral fraud, human rights violations, red-tagging, and corruption. The possible alliance of CTG and anti-administration groups/individuals should be taken into consideration. It is significant to note that CFOs have planned to conduct mass actions during PBBM's first SONA and 50th Martial Law anniversary (#ML50 and #NeverAgain) to sustain their call on COMELEC's failure of May 2022 polls and the abolition of NTF ELCAC and Anti-Terrorism Law, among others.

The NPA's planned nationwide tactical offensives against government forces in the countryside is to demonstrate its defiance to the Marcos administration and project an image of strength.

As of this report, there was no monitored major terror plan targeting the transportation systems in the country. However, Local Terrorist Groups (LTGs) were monitored planning to bomb bus company in Zamboanga City; bus company, fast-food restaurant and commercial establishments in Isabela City; commercial establishment in Lamitan City; Husky Tours bus company in General Santos City and Cotabato City; South Seas Mall in Cotabato City; and public markets in General Santos City and Tacurong City. It also plans to conduct IED attacks targeting passenger buses from Cotabato City to General Santos City passing through Polomolok; and along highways and crowded areas including churches, markets and terminals in Midsayap, Cotabato. LTGs also plan to lay IEDs: along the highways and public places in Datu Saudi Ampatuan in Maguindanao and nearby municipalities and provinces; public markets, terminals and remittance centers in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, said province; and in Isulan, Sultan Kudarat. Meantime, terrorists are reportedly extorting money from the management of Yellow Bus Liner in Tacurong City. In the NCR, NICA recommended **Moderate with Level 3 Security Measures** as precautionary measure to prevent any terrorist attacks. The NCR is an ideal target due to its strategic importance as the country's center of political and economic activities.

In the light of possible threat to the transportation systems of the country, the nationwide OTS Transportation Security Levels for **JULY 2022** were as follows: **Security Condition 1 with Enhanced Security Measures** at all airports; **Security Level 1 with Enhanced Security Measures at all seaports**; and **Security Level 1 with Enhanced Security Measures** at all land mass transportation facilities.

The transportation system will not be spared from terror threats as targets or collateral targets considering its vulnerability. The enhancement of security will supplement security measures and procedures currently in place at airports, seaports and bus ports/terminals. Nonetheless, concerned transportation agencies/stakeholders should remain vigilant and coordinate with the proper intelligence/security units.
